Union Notes:

There isn't currently is a cashpoint /ATM on the Cambridge Campus. The closest cashpoint to the Cambridge campus is Tesco's on East Road or The Grafton Centre.

The inconvenience caused by having to go to East Road can encourage students to go elsewhere for food such as the Tesco or KFC therefore resulting in students relying on snacks or fast food as their main source rather than a healthy substantial meal from the University cafeteria.

The Students' Union is working with our University to develop a Cashless Campus system where students will be able to load money onto their Ruskin Card and use this at the facilities on campus. This new facility is to be piloted soon and will be rolled out across all campuses as soon as the pilot is complete.

Union Believes:

Students at Anglia Ruskin University should have fair and easy access to the facilities available on our campuses.

Requiring students to go off campus for cash to be able to get food during the day does not demonstrate fair opportunities for students who have access needs.

Union Resolves:

To continue to lobby our University for a cashpoint on our campuses, preferably one that is free of charge to use.

To continue to work with our University to ensure the Cashless Campus system is best fit for our students.
