- Queering the Sciences: the passing of this policy would increase direct research into improving the lives of LGBT+ people, to provide more information for LGBT+ people wanting to go into the sciences.
- End Degree Certificate Discrimination: Would allow those with identity changes to have their degrees changed without any further hassle to them, ensure that non-binary titles are also allowed by universities, that this service would be free of charge and for this policy to be sent as a motion to the next National Conference.
- Liberation Starts in the Library: to increase the resources in libraries for LGBT+ people, and to provide a safe space/procedure for LGBT+ students should they need to complain that resources are lacking.
- Access to Education: to encourage LGBT+ societies to diversify their events to be more inclusive to Trans*, asexual and queer people.
- Education/Teachers: To work with teachers and HEIs to include LGBT+ people in curriculums.
- Student Sex Monitoring in HEIs: To lobby all UK HEIs which do not currently allow students to declare a sex other than 'male' or 'female' to allow students to do so.
