
#### Progress on priority campaign(s)

### 1. Representation in Sport update

- I met with the Head of Sport and his colleague early in the semester to go through and discuss the first draft of the Strategic Partnership Agreement written by myself and SU colleagues. This was positive and are due to meet again in the coming weeks to finalise the document and get it signed off by both parties (AA and SU). This document will be used as an understanding of expectations from the university and from the student body, in terms of sport.

## 2. Space update

I ran a consultation for students on how they would like to see the developments of Peter Taylor House and Tindal be used. It was found that the strongest preference was a majority of the spaces being available to relax and socialise with peers, with some of the space being allocated to allow students to meet as a group or individually and study if need be. These findings will be used to inform the designer on what kind of furniture will be suitable for the spaces.

#### 4. Day to day updates

- Monthly 1-1's with the Vice Chancellor This is a chance for the Officer Team to
  update the Vice Chancellor on the work of the SU and provide him with feedback
  from students regularly. It is also a chance for the VC to update the SU on matters
  happening within the university.
- Enhancing representation Grace and I are working with Dan to flesh out and
  develop the responsibilities of the course rep to enhance the effectiveness of their
  role. We are also developing the relationships between course reps, faculty reps, VP's
  and union staff and clearly identifying each roles responsibilities, to better working
  relationships and understanding of expectations of each.
- Officer Training We are working on putting together an effective training schedule
  for the newly elected Officer Team and Executive committee. I am working with the
  current Officer Team, CEO and HR manager to ensure all of the relevant areas are
  covered to ensure they are equipped to undertake their roles. This is increasingly
  important as the roles have changed.
- **FMS Faculty Forum and Board** I attended the first Faculty of Medical Science forum which was set up by our representation team to gather student feedback and views on particular issues within their course. This was well attended by student reps from undergraduate paramedic course and a PhD student, but for future forums we will put more emphasis on the importance of reps attending. The issues raised and discussed by students were;
  - Increased access to resources/space
  - Consistency of in-class assessment guidance
  - Postgraduate Research students teaching opportunities
  - Improved provision from personal tutors
  - Improved communication from teaching staff
  - Effectiveness of materials on VLE

All of this feedback was then compiled into a paper and presented to the FHSCE Faculty Board (chaired by the Dean of the faculty, James Hampton-Till) where solutions to the issues will be sought.

- Governance and Board Effectiveness review We have recruited many new External trustees and committee experts to sit on our Board of Trustees and newly constituted sub-committees. These include:
  - Appointments and Governance committee
  - HR and People Engagement committee

#### - Finance and Risk committee

The implementation of this new structure and recruitment of external individuals with particular expertise will help to strengthen our governance and enable us to think strategically about the future of the union as a charity and achieve the goals in our strategic plan.
