## NSS Charities

The National Student Survey is a UK-wide survey given to final-year students in higher education which helps students to feedback about their university experiences. Last year, by giving £2 per completed survey, ARU donated over £10,000 to charities! The money was shared between two student-chosen charities Cambridgeshire, Peterborough, and South Lincolnshire (CPSL) Mind and Dementia Adventure (Essex).<sup>1</sup>

This year, ARU will once more give £2 to charity per each NSS survey completed by ARU students. We are also again given the opportunity to choose the charities who will receive these donations.
