Role Description

As a Course Rep your responsibilities are:

- To proactively seek out feedback from your fellow students, to represent their academic interests.
- To present student concerns and feedback to appropriate departments and members of staff.
- To attend and take part in your Student Staff Liaison Committee (SSLC) meetings.
- To attend Course Rep training with the Students' Union.
- To communicate with students on your course on a regular basis.

Alongside these responsibilities, you will have the opportunity to:

- Get involved with Students' Union campaigns and activities.
- Log volunteering hours and skills on your Volunteer Profile.
- Be nominated for and win Rep of the Month awards.
- Sit on panels and meetings within ARU to improve academic achievement and help make decisions on behalf of students.
- Develop skills and attributes that will benefit your personal and professional development.

Time Commitment

Being an effective representative should take approximately 15 hours per trimester. This includes attending training, attending meetings, and consulting with and reporting back to the students that you represent.
